



## **2008 Spring K-Ball Program** ***Frequently Asked Questions***

This fact sheet is intended to provide you with some information about the Spring 2008 Kindergarten baseball program. The following questions are most commonly asked by residents about the program.

### ***Does my child need to be currently enrolled in Kindergarten to participate?***

Yes, your child needs to be enrolled in the Westwood Public School System or an equivalent private school Kindergarten program.

### ***Is the program open to both Boys and Girls?***

Yes, the program is designed for both boys and girls. Since there is no Girl's Softball program available until 1<sup>st</sup> Grade, we encourage all kindergartners to participate.

### ***My child has never really played before. Will it be instructional?***

Yes, the objective of the program is to introduce the child to the game of baseball in a fun and supportive environment. The focus of the coaches is to instruct the players on the basics of the game (hitting, catching, fielding & running). Casual, non-scored games are played each week as part of the instruction.


### ***When does it start? Do they play during the week or the weekends?***

The spring season will start the last week of April and run until mid-June. Most games are played during weekdays with some on week ends depending upon enrollment, weather and field availability.

***Where are the games played?***

The games are scheduled to be played at the School Street Playground facility. There are 2 baseball diamonds behind the new playground that will support 2 simultaneous games (4 teams).

***Where should we park for the games?***

This is perhaps the most important issue for parents to understand and follow week to week in the season. Parking for KBall is limited and not encouraged in the School Street Playground lot. Westwood Little League respects the neighborhoods surrounding the facility and has requested parking for games be either in the town lot behind the Islington Barbershop or behind the playground on Beacon Street which can be accessed via Brookfield Road off Washington Street. This will limit traffic issues and allow 2 games to be played simultaneously.
