Code of Conduct



Board Members, Managers, Coaches, Players, Parents or an other Spectator shall not:

- At any time, lay a hand upon, push, shove, strike or threaten to strike an umpire/official.
- Issue personal verbal or physical abuse upon any umpire/official for any real or imaginary belief of a wrong decision or judgement
- Openly dissent with an umpire's decision by throwing of gloves, helmets, hats, bats, balls or any other unsportsman-like conduct
- Use unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of a game against the body of an opposing player
- Physically attack upon any board member, umpire, manager, coach, player or spectator
- Use profane, obscene, or vulgar language at any time
- Appear on the field of play, stands or elsewhere on the WLL complex while intoxicated
- Gamble on the outcome of any game
- Speak disrespectfully to a manager, coach, umpire or official of the league
- Speak publicly in a derogatory or abusive manner regarding any specific plays or players during the game



The Board of Directors will review all infractions of the above Code of Conduct. Depending on the nature, seriousness, or frequency of the infraction the Board may assess disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from Westwood Little League.
