

## **TIE BREAKER PROCESS FOR POOL PLAY IN ALL DIVISIONS**

### **TWO-WAY TIE**

In the case of a two-way tie, the winner of pool play head to head game between the teams involved in the tie will determine which team advances.

### **THREE-WAY TIE**

If there is a three-way tie, and no clear winner can be determined on head-to-head competition, the total number of runs given up in all pool play games, divided by the number of innings played on defense, is computed for each of the three teams involved in the tie. The ONE team with the lowest “run differential” advances.

**Note 1:** *If a team only plays part of a half-inning on defense before a game is ended, that will count as a full half-inning for the purposes of computing the run differential.*

**Note 2:** *In the case of a forfeit, the score (6-0 for Majors and below; 7-0 for 50/70 and above) and the number of innings (six and seven respectively) will apply in this tabulation. This will be the case in a forfeit regardless of the scoring in a partial or complete game.*
