



Uniform Care Instructions

One of the largest organizational assets we have is our inventory of reversible uniform jerseys and shorts. Over the past several years, the SAC Board has implemented a uniform replacement program and we have upgraded almost our entire inventory of uniforms for 4th-6th grade players without raising the fees we charge our families. This program was funded almost exclusively from proceeds from our annual Holiday Tournament.

That being said, it is of the upmost importance that families take good care of these uniforms as they are “on loan” to you during the season. Please help take care of these uniforms for the next generation of players.

Here are a few reminders regarding uniform care.

1. Players should only wear their uniform shorts and jerseys to games or scrimmages. Uniforms should not be worn to practice or for casual wear.
2. **Uniform Care Instructions**
Uniforms must be properly handled while washing and drying so they will last for several years. Please follow these guidelines for washing / drying the uniform:
 - Machine wash **cold**.
 - Wash with **like colors**.
 - **Do not use Fabric Softener**, it will cause printed cloth patterns to separate from material.
 - **Do not use chlorine bleach**, as the chance of color separation and the weakening of some material is increased
 - **HANG DRY ONLY**. Do NOT put the uniforms in the DRYER. This causes the numbers to peel off!
 - Do not dry clean or iron.
3. **Failure to return your uniform at the end of the season will result in paying for a replacement.** If loss or damage of the uniform occurs and a determination is made that the loss or damage is a result of improper cleaning care or negligence, you will be held responsible for the repair or replacement of the item(s).
