Discussion: PeeWee 1 Valley League Championship Jackets

PW1 team proposes to have TYSA purchase jackets for championship teams. TYSA would do this moving forward as an incentive to other teams. Other youth sports organizations in town do something similar for league champions however the league formats are quite different.

The board expressed concern on the number of Valley League Champions and that this wasn't done for prior teams. A proposal was made by a board member to allow the team to do an independent fund-raiser to help defray the cost of the jackets.

Motion: TYSA to contribute \$400 towards the purchase of championship jackets for the PW1 team as a result of their winning the Valley League Championship for their division.
