We will be using the Middle School South Gym for all girl campers in grades 3-9. During the morning session, time will be spent focusing on the development of individual skills. Campers will be instructed in all aspects of individual offensive and defensive basketball during teaching sessions. Coach Hennelly will run stations for older campers while current and alumni GD Varsity girl players will facilitate stations for the younger campers. These stations will cover shooting, ball handling, passing, screening and man-to-man defense. League games, arranged by age groups, are devoted to developing the team concept and the incorporation of the skills learned during teaching stations.
