



Privacy & COPPA Policies

The Mokena Baseball & Softball Association (MBSA) collects registration and customer information through its website and camp and clinic registration activities for use by Mokena Baseball and Softball Association only, for the purposes of periodic communication with past and future Association members, as well as those interested in information about Mokena Baseball and Softball activities.

The MBSA does not provide or share our online customer data with any outside entity for any reason except for the purposes of completing credit card or other financial transactions on behalf of a customer.

The MBSA does not collect personal information directly from children under the age of 13 as directed by the FTC's Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) of 1998. Periodic promotions, public relations and marketing efforts in the sports industry and elsewhere, for the MBSA, are directed specifically to parents and families interested in baseball-related events and products.

The MBSA does not condone or distribute unsolicited email on its behalf. All promotional and informational (online newsletters) email communication to our customer database is done strictly on an opt-in basis. Recipients may opt-out of future mailings at any time.

However, when registering for an MBSA program, the Guardian grants permission for the Participant(s) and Guardian(s) to be photographed and/or videotaped while they are participating in any activity associated with the MBSA. The Guardian also grants permission for the photos and/or video depicting the Participants' and Guardians' image(s) to be used on the organization's website, MBSA.org and affiliates, content sites (i.e., YouTube.com, Shutterfly.com, Picasa.com), event and game programs, press releases, brochures and newspaper article(s).
