**Location:** Forekicks in Norfolk (back indoor turf fields)

**Dates:** Saturdays - Jan 7th through Feb 25th (8 sessions)

**Cost:** Boys 3<sup>th</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> Grades - \$100 (5:00-6:00pm)

Boys 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grades - \$165 (6:00-7:30pm)

Girls 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grades - \$145 (4:00-5:30pm)

### **Boys 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>:**

Featuring a skill development session supervised and run by our MYL coaches. This is a great way to prepare for the Spring season, and go over important stick skills and game play. Following the skills portion - some competitive 3v3 balanced teams playing some up-tempo small ball games.

### **Boys 5<sup>th</sup>-8th:**

Skill development sessions supervised and run by Medfield HS Asst. Coach Daggett Morse. Coach Morse played locally at Catholic Memorial High School ('07), Hartwick College ('11) and internationally at Leicester University (UK, '12). He has been the Assistant Varsity Coach at Medfield High School since the 2013 season - Eastern Mass Champions and State Runners Up in 2013, Division 2 State Champions in 2014, 2015 and 2016. Coach Morse has coached 9 All-Americans (16 total selections) and 4 Division 2 State Players of the Year. Morse has also coached for Laxachusetts club lacrosse for the past 2 years. Also assisting will be Medfield Varsity lacrosse players.

### **Girls 5<sup>th</sup>-8th:**

Colleen Manning will run the girls clinic and will focus on skill development for the first portion of the session and game situations for the 2nd portion. Colleen is entering her 3rd season as the Head Coach for Sharon HS where she led the Eagles to its 1st MIAA playoff appearance and was named D1 Coach of the Year. Also assisting will be Medfield Varsity lacrosse players.
