Disclosures & Permissions:

1. Members are advised to check the MSC website regularly for all MSC announcements.
MSC will NOT publish notices in local papers or call or email.
2. MSC wants to develop your child so they will have the skills to enjoy and love the game for a life time.
3. All travel players will receive one travel uniform when they enter the program free of charge.
If you need a new uniform, you will mark off the size and check current member.
You will be charged with the cost of the uniform. Please record the cost in appropriate box and make the payment. MSC will not order the uniform; you will be responsible for uniform order.
4. Fund-raising events include but are not limited to car washes, MSC soccer games, Awards picnic, etc.
5. MSC has an age-appropriate curriculum that is nationally recognized to develop players based on their age and development. MSC does not move players up to the next division based on parent request. MSC hires professional organizations to continually update our curriculum and developmental programs. MSC is constantly providing opportunities for our coaches to improve their skills.
6. FREE memberships are available to members who lead MSC to successful grants or sponsorships.
One (1) FREE FAMILY membership per year per full \$2,500 grant increment. Examples:

1-time grant	\$2,500	1-year membership
2-year grant	\$5,000 per year	2-year membership
1-time grant	\$3,500	1-year membership
2-year grant	\$7,000 per year	2-year membership
Perpetual grant	\$6,000 per year	2 perpetual family memberships

- MSC is a 501(c)(3) organization. Grants & Sponsorships are tax deductible.
 - The membership is fully transferable only once prior to each Fall season.
 - Transfers of up to 200% only, e.g. 2 kids transfer to 4 kids.
 - All transfers must be made in writing (or email) prior to placement of Fall uniform orders. Registration rules and timetables apply.
 - Perpetual awardees may assign transfer responsibilities to MSC at any time.
 - Free memberships apply to immediate family members only, unless fully transferred by the qualifying member.
 - For membership to be awarded the following full season, funds must be received by MSC by the cut-off date, i.e. Fall uniform order date.
7. Uniform orders are final, unless an error is attributable to MSC.
Cost of replacement including shipping will be borne by the member.
 8. U-10 travel players must also participate in the in-town league.
U-10 travel players will get in-town uniforms free of charge.
 9. MSC abides by the fair play rules of CJSA and FIFA.
 - MSC has zero tolerance for acts of verbal abuse or physical abuse to person or property.
 - MSC has zero tolerance for acts of racial discrimination and verbal assault.
 - MSC has zero tolerance for acts of sexual discrimination and verbal assault.
 - MSC has zero tolerance for acts of abuse against referees.
 - MSC reserves the right to remove members or parents and revoke memberships.
 10. Bounced check payments are the responsibility of the member. The member agrees to reimburse MSC \$25.00 and all related bank fees. The member must make best efforts to communicate with the Board and rectify the situation. Only cash payments will be accepted after the bounced check. If payment is not made before uniforms are ordered, the member shall NOT hold MSC liable for any actions that lead to forfeiture of current or future membership.
 11. It is entirely random when MSC constitutes a team without a volunteer coach.
I understand that I may be called upon to coach my child's team.
 12. Grant reporting requires that we conduct surveys and collect data. Participation is mandatory.
I hereby give the MSC authority to access my children's CMT scores and school grades.
I understand that this is done for the purpose of awards & grant reporting only.
MSC will hold all collected information in complete confidentiality.
 13. I agree to allow the MSC to use and publish pictures taken during all MSC events.
