President's Report

- CVL Update Meeting
 - For 2010, a zero tolerance policy will be in effect (includes coaches and parents)
- Football playoffs
 - Dolphins vs. East Haven – Saturday, November 14, 11:00 a.m. at Brian McMahon (Ridgefield backed out of playoffs)
 - Dolphins will be two coaches short
 - Fill ins need to complete absenteeism forms to coach at this game
- PAL
 - If NYF becomes a member of PAL, insurance premium will be waived (as long as our uniforms say PAL somewhere on them)
 - Savings of \$6,700 annually
 - Jim Wrinn to speak with Chief of Police for Norwalk, Harry Rilling on November 12

- Banquet
 - Board looking at other options for this year other than Continental Manor

- Costs approximately \$17,000 (including trophies) to have banquet at Continental Manor
 - Possibilities
 - 5th grade and up – coaches plan their own parties – league pays
 - Ferris Hill Club
 - Hold banquet in 2 shifts if place doesn't accommodate 400 people at one time
 - Need to decide on type of trophy to give
 - Need to go back thru program book to determine 5 year players
- Flag Football
 - Brought in \$6,000
 - Trophies have been ordered

Vice-President's Report

- Uniforms
 - Board agrees that the green game jerseys are fine
 - Possibly look at new uniform distributor for Cheer (currently Stadium)
 - Bert to look into new pans and price of new girdles
- Equipment Drop off
 - November 15 – coaches to bring all equipment back to Brian McMahon between 10:00-12:00
