

# *Clinton Invitational Soccer Tournament 2017*

Dear Coaches,

First, we would like to thank you for participating in the 23<sup>rd</sup> annual Clinton Invitational Soccer Tournament. The Tournament Committee hopes that your team enjoy themselves, act responsibly and achieve your team goals.

Enclosed are directions to our fields, your schedule, tournament rules and in particular the rules regarding the "MLS" style shoot-out for Sunday tiebreaker games (U11, U12 & U14 only).

The U10 girls will play on Saturday and the U10 boys on Sunday. All U10's will play four (4) games and receive a participation award for each player. Coaches, please keep the scores reasonable and remember to have your certified roster with you at all times. They will be checked prior to your first game.

For the first time this year we will be using two (2) fields at the new Morgan High School. The Peter's Complex and Morgan High School are connected and it is just a short 3-minute walk between the fields at the two (2) facilities. When at Morgan, the facilities at Peter's Complex are available for your use. When at the Peter's or Indian River Complexes please stop by our concession stand and T-Shirt vendor areas.

This year as always, parking will be tight at the Peter's Sports Complex. We strongly urge you to carpool and remember that there are additional parking areas available at the adjacent Joel and Morgan Schools.

For all U11, U12 & U14 teams, your certified roster and player passes will be checked prior to your first game on each day. At this time they will be placed into an envelope and held during the game. At the completion of the game the envelope will be returned to you and it is your responsibility to bring it to your next game and turn it into the referee for that game. Please remember to review the rules concerning the "MLS" style penalty kicks as they are unique to our tournament.

All teams should remember to bring two (2) different color jerseys or pennies for jersey color conflicts. Home team (first mentioned) shall be responsible for changing. This is a rain or shine event.
