The Code of Conduct and Behavior for all Participants

As a participant in **Norwalk Community Soccer Club (NCSC)** there are rules and a standards of conduct that must be followed at all times. I will follow these rules or I may be suspended from play or dismissal from participation at **NCSC**.

As participant player of **NCSC**. I _____, understand that there are rules of conduct that I must follow at all times. By signing this code of conduct I am making a commitment to the club and to my team including the following:

- Individual and team discipline is the best way to maintain safety
- I will treat all Teammates, Coaches, Referees, League Officials, Opponents with respect at all times.
- **I will make every effort to attend all my team practices and games, as my teammates are counting on me to be part of a soccer team.**
- I will never engage in fighting of any kind
- I will respect the decisions of the referees and my coach
- I will bring all my necessary uniform and equipment to my practices and games. Soccer cleats, shin guards, soccer ball and water
- I will never wear jewelry to my practices or games.
- The use of profanity of any kind towards my Teammates, Referees, Coaches or any other person is totally unacceptable.
- I understand that under no circumstance shall I leave a game or practice field without permission from my coach or assistant coach.
- **I am making a commitment to my parents and my team that I will work hard in school, complete my homework and that my grades are as high as they can be.**
- I will always show good sportsmanship. However, I understand that if I am disqualified during a game by getting a red card or for inappropriate behavior by my coaches, referees or league officials; I will be suspended for one game. Continuing discipline problems will not be tolerated and could result in being suspended or removed from the team.
