### Rule or By-Law Effected

<p>11.1 All Players are required to play within the area where they reside or attend school. All returning Players requesting a waiver out of their home area as defined above will be subject to a mandatory three game delayed start to the season. This does not apply to "New" players to JMFA or players residing in an area outside JMFA. The only exceptions being:</p> <p>11.1.1 JMFA Executive board or board appointed review committee approval. All appeals must be given to JMFA in writing with supporting documentation prior to bracketing for that season.</p> <p>11.2 ALL WAIVER FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY BOTH AREA PRESIDENTS INVOLVED AND APPROVED BY THE COUNTY PRESIDENT.</p> <p>11.2.1 If the President of the Area that the child wishes to move from refuses to grant the waiver, the accepting area may ask the JMFA Executive Board to approve the waiver without said directors signature,</p> <p>11.2.1.1 the Executive Board may allow or deny the waiver at their discretion.</p> <p>11.3 All players waived to another area must go into the blind draft or to the team with the smallest roster on</p>	<p>11.1 All Players are required to play within the area where they reside or attend school. All appeals must be given to JMFA in writing with supporting documentation prior to bracketing for that season.</del></p> <p>11.1.1 All returning Players requesting a waiver out of their home area as defined above will be allowed one move from their home area in their playing career within JMFA with no penalty. Any other moves will result in the penalty being enforced. This does not apply to "New" players to JMFA or players residing in an area outside JMFA. The only exceptions being:</p> <p>11.1.2 Returning Player waiver penalties: A. First waiver will incur no penalty. B. Any move thereafter, unless returning to home area, will incur a 3 game suspension for the first 3 games of the season.</p> <p>11.1.1 JMFA Executive board or board appointed review committee approval. All appeals must be given to JMFA in writing with supporting documentation prior to</p>



<p>the date of the waiver as specified by the County President. <i>No team, coach, division or player requests will be allowed with the exception of division 3 requests</i></p> <p>11.5 Whichever area the player elects to play in, that area henceforth shall be considered by all to be their permanent area for their remaining years of play in the JMFA program.</p> <p>11.5.1 This would mean that a player that is part of the 20% on the roster and chooses to stay on a team the following year, from that point on they become grandfathered on as part of that team.
