

Summary of Proposed Changes to AHA Bylaws
For consideration June 19, 2018

The main purpose for the proposed changes to the bylaws is to add key positions and provide needed structure to the Board of Directors. These changes were discussed at recent board meetings and were well-received by the existing Board of Directors. Specifically, the proposed structure adds two Vice President positions to complement the already existing Vice President position. This results in three Vice Presidents, responsible for coach and player development, membership, and business and operations, respectively. Moreover, this new structure provides the AHA community with a better sense of who to approach with a problem or an issue. The proposed changes are also consistent with the Association’s commitment to marketing. Specifically, this proposal adds three new membership-related board positions: a Fundraising and Sponsorship Director, a Social Media Director, and a Volunteer and Special Events Director. These positions will help improve communications with AHA members. Among other things, the proposed bylaw changes details director duties and identifies board committee memberships and responsibilities. The proposed changes are illustrated in the draft organization chart below. Additionally, there are some administrative and clerical clean-ups included in these proposed changes.
