- Understand that your attitude can influence the players, coaches, and other parents and spectators.
- Understand that referee, just as coaches and players, are attempting to do their best
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, there would not be a program for your child.
- Do not use foul language or harass players, coaches or officials.
- Respect the game officials and refrain from questioning their decisions or from addressing them in a loud, disrespectful or abusive manner.
- Ensure that your child is at all games and practices at the required time or provide the coach with an appropriate excuse beforehand.
- Report to the coach all injuries, special medical conditions or extenuating circumstances that may affect the player.
