Schedule

Attached is the schedule for the festival. Please note: this schedule is subject to change. The final schedule will be e-mailed to coaches and posted on the Moorestown Lacrosse Club's website by Thursday May 13th. There will be program books and schedules handed out the day of the festival and schedule inserts as well.

Rules

Festival rules for the girls and boys are attached and can also be found on the Moorestown Lacrosse Club's website.

New this year, all coaches immediately following the game and before your team hand shake must meet with the referees of your game to verify the score and initial the game card. The referees will be required to initial as well. You should have an assistant coach keep score for the game as well to avoid discrepancies. Thank You!!!

Round Robin / Championship Round Tie Breaker

All teams are in a specific bracket and will play four games within their bracket in a round robin format. 2 pts. for a win, 1 pt. for a tie (No OT in the round robin.) There will then be a playoff in each bracket (except for the 3rd/4th Grade.) Playoffs will be decided by total points earned in the 4 games. Tie-breakers will be head to head, then goals allowed – if necessary, then goal differential (maximum 7 goal differential per game counts for the tiebreaker) – if necessary, then a coin flip.

Boys: In the championship round, in the event of a tie, the boys will use a braveheart competition to determine the winner of the game. **Girls:** In the championship round, in the event of a tie, the girls will play a five-minute sudden death overtime. If the game is still tied at the end of the overtime, a three-girl penalty shot competition will be used to determine the winner of the game. All penalty shots must be taken by different players.

Directions to Moorestown High School

Directions to Moorestown High School are provided below, and can also be found on the Moorestown Lacrosse Club's website at www.moorestownlax.com under the "directions" link. Mapquest directions or GPS coordinates can be obtained using 350 Bridgeboro Road, Moorestown, NJ 08057 as the destination address.

From 295 South: take Exit 40B to Rt. 38 West

After getting on Route 38, take a right at the sign for Marter Ave/East 38/295
Stay in right hand lane and make a right at the stop sign
Go to the second stop light and make a left onto Main Street
Go ½ a mile and make a right hand turn onto North Stanwick Road
Follow North Stanwick 1.3 miles and turn right onto Bridgeboro Rd.
In 1/10 of a mile the entrance is on the right.

From the Rt. 38 East

After the Moorestown Mall:
The 1st light is Pleasant Valley Ave. The 2nd light is Church Rd. The 3rd light is a traffic light allowing traffic to enter Rt. 38
The 4th light is Moorestown Mount Laurel Rd. Take the jug handle on the right before the light to cross over Rt. 38.
Make a right at the first light (½ a mile) onto Main Street (Rt. 537)
Go 4/10 of a mile and turn left onto North Stanwick. Follow North Stanwick 1.3 miles and turn right onto Bridgeboro Rd.
In 1/10 of a mile the entrance is on the right.

Parking

We anticipate 118 teams for the festival and consequently a large number of cars. We encourage teams to carpool, if possible. Parking will be available at the High School and Middle School. Parking is also available on neighboring streets in Stanwick Glen (Paddock Path, Stonehouse Road, Signal Light Road) and on Golf View and Westover Roads.

We ask that you be mindful of the community and residences around the school. Please do not obstruct driveways or intersections or disregard "No Parking" signs when parking off-site for the event. Moorestown Police Department works with our Club and our event and respects our desire to build the game of lacrosse but also has the responsibility to ensure the safety of all the participants who come to the event, pedestrians and motorists. They will ticket and tow illegally parked cars. In the parking lot of both schools, please park only in legal painted spaces to allow for emergency vehicles to pass safely on the entire complex. We will have volunteers positioned during high traffic times to assist with parking. If your club has any questions please feel free to contact us for clarification.

PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE PARKING LOT FOR THE *FLYING FEATHER* PRODUCE STAND LOCATED ON BRIDGEBORO ROAD.

Registration/Team Check-In

All teams must report to the Registration Tent located adjacent to the Moorestown High School Concession Stand and Main Field (Field 1) prior to playing the first game for the day. Teams will be given festival programs, schedules, field maps, and team give away bags, upon check-in. Please have a coach come to the check in, especially if you are bringing final paperwork. Please allow time to check in especially early in the morning.

Team payment, roster and waiver liability forms must be on file with the Registrar at the Registration Tent prior to playing the team's first game for the day.

Recycling

In the spirit of staying with the green theme as in years past, and in conjunction with Burlington County, we ask your help in collecting any recyclable containers on the day of the festival. At check-in you will receive more information about this program and a bag for collecting recyclables brought to the festival by your team. Please use this for all your drinks and recyclables. Containers will be throughout the grounds for depositing these items.

Pre-Ordered Merchandise Pick-up / Festival Merchandise Sales

Pre-ordered merchandise can be picked up at the Registration Tent located adjacent to the Moorestown High School Concession Stand and Main Field (Field 1). The day of the festival, merchandise can be purchased at the Merchandise Tent located by the Main Field (Field 1) and the Information Tents located on the Bridgeboro Road Fields (Fields 2-5) and Middle School Fields (Fields 9-13).

Food / Concessions / Mouthguards

Food and beverage will be sold at the main Concession stand by the Main Field (Field 1). A limited selection of food and beverages will be available at the Bridgeboro Road (Fields 2-5) and Middle School (Fields 9-13) Information Tents. An ice-cream truck is available near the middle school. Mouthguards will be sold at the main concession stand and satellite information tents.

No Pets / No Grilling

The festival is held on the grounds of the Moorestown public schools. For the protection of the fields and festival participants, we do not allow pets or grilling on school property during the festival. This will be strictly enforced.

Bathrooms

Bathrooms are located throughout the festival venues, as well as the main concession stand.

First Aide/Athletic Trainers

The First Aide Station will be located at the Registration Tent adjacent to the main concession stand and main field (Field 1). Volunteer medical personnel will be on-call at the station throughout the day. The Moorestown Ambulance Squad and high school athletic trainers will be on-site the day of the festival as well.

Master Score Boards / Game Results

The master score boards for game results will be located by the Registration Tent adjacent to the Main Field (Field 1).
