

FIELD UPKEEP

The following applies to all three 90' diamonds: NHS, Bresnahan and Salisbury.
Failure to follow the procedures may result in the loss of privileges on these fields.

Before each game remove the tarps and put them in one of the dugouts along with the spikes/ties used to hold them.

After each game or practice the following needs to be done even if teams are following you on the field:

Rake the pitcher's mound

Rake the home plate area, batters box and catcher's box

Rake the base paths

Drag the infield

At the end of the day, last team(s) is to cover mound and batter's box with tarps and secure them. Clean out dugouts and fields of trash.

At the field in Salisbury, put away rakes, mats and bases lock up the storage areas.

At the Bresnahan, put away rakes and lock the shed. Bases are left on the field. Drag mats are left behind the backstop

At NHS, Put rakes and small drag mats in the 3rd base dugout. Bases are left on the field.

After games both teams should do the above as it will take only a few minutes with all pitching in.
