Volunteer mentors must be 14 years or older. As a mentor you have an opportunity to make an impact on a player's life by being a role model and a friend, as well as an Ambassador for Storm Hockey. The responsibilities of a mentor are:

1. A commitment to attend 50% of Storm practices during our season that is from October through March (usually a total of 26 sessions)
