

BBSL Cal Ripken Baseball Playing Up Policy

A player may request to play up into the next higher age division by following this procedure.

1. The player must have played one year in his/her current division.
2. The participant must meet the minimum age for the upper division.
3. The player must assess above the Upper Control Limit (UCL) of his/her normal (current) age division assessment and above the Lower Control Limit (LCL) of the higher age division. The control limits are calculated from the Standard Deviation of the preseason assessment scores.
4. After step 2, the parent/guardian may contact the division coordinator with a written request via email to the Brookline Baseball League Coordinator in which you are seeking to have your child play-up, clearly stating the reasons for the request. **See Brookline-Baseball website (Board Members tab) for League Coordinator email addresses.**
5. There must be an open roster spot in the upper division.
6. The player will be placed onto a team indicated by the UCL and LCL.
