

Traveling Eagles Parents,

Congratulations on becoming a Traveling Eagle for the Spring 2010 season!

This year the uniforms will be handled differently than in past years. AAU is the expert in regards to uniforms, sizing, and collecting money. So, it was determined by the Board to let them handle all aspects in regards to the Traveling Eagle uniforms. A summary of the process for the 2010 season is as follows:

1. Parent/players go to AAU for sizing, makes deposit, AAU verify all information, and AAU will provide a receipt for uniform with deposit made and balance due
2. AAU notifies uniform coordinator that uniforms are ready for pickup, then uniform coordinator will contact all parents, via an email
3. parent goes to AAU to pay balance of uniform costs and pickup uniform
4. if there are any problems, the parents will contact AAU directly

The information below reiterates, in detail, the information that was discussed at the Parent meeting on Thursday, December 17, 2009.

1. Uniform sizing

AAU will be available on December 28, 2009 thru December 30, 2009

AAU hours are 8:00am to 5:00pm each day

Alternate days for sizing will be January 4, 2010 and January 5, 2010

To guarantee that uniforms are ready in time, the above schedule must be met

If the above schedule is a problem, please contact AAU directly

2. Pricing

Pricing is per the AAU quote, plus 6% tax

\$115.00 for youth sizes

\$130.00 for adult sizes

AAU will collect all monies for uniforms (Traveling Eagles will not be involved)

AAU requires at least 50% of the uniform cost upon sizing (ordering) of uniform

AAU requires the balance of the uniform upon pickup of uniform - no exceptions

AAU accepts all forms of credit cards, except American Express

3. Uniform pickup

AAU will contact the Traveling Eagles when all uniforms are ready for pickup

The Traveling Eagles will notify parents when uniforms are ready for pickup

Uniforms will be ready by NLT January 30, 2010, provided sizing is done on time

4. Optional items (helmets, bat bags, gloves, etc.)

Optional items are available for players and their family at the same price

XXL or larger sizes have an extra charge

Player and parents items will be kept as separate orders

Belts and socks are also available at AAU for an additional charge

5. AAU Web site for Traveling Eagles
