Thank you for registering for the 2009-2010 Hockey Season. Blades Multi-Plex Arenas is a family business and privately held. Our objective is to maintain a fun, safe, and affordable atmosphere for ALL. We seek to accomplish our objective by asking each of you to help adhere to the below points. The listed points below will help increase personal safety and minimize unnecessary damages and injuries thus ensuring affordable services.

- Please **DO NOT** bring outside food and drinks into the facility. However, players are permitted to being in a bottle of water or a sports drink. Parents and spectators are not permitted to bring outside food and drinks into the facility.
- There is no charge for renting a locker room for your team, but prior to taking charge of the locker room, you will be required to complete a locker room rental sheet and provide collateral (such as car keys). Damages to the locker room will be the responsibility of the individual renting the locker room. In order to avoid damage and cleaning fees, please clean up the locker rooms after each use (i.e. pick up after yourselves.)
- ALL activities must always take place ON the ice during your regularly scheduled practices or game times. **DO NOT** practice in the hallways or the snack bar area (i.e. no "stick and puck," running, etc.)
- Everyone is welcome to participate in one of our many scheduled public ice or stick & puck sessions. Spectators will not be charged, but if you plan on skating, you **MUST** pay prior to getting on the ice.
- Team Ice rentals should always be scheduled through your team coaches and NMAHA Ice Scheduler. ALL other ice requests can be requested through Steve @ 263-1092.
- Sales or solicitation of Hockey equipment, accessories, etc is **NOT permitted**. If you have further questions, please contact Kristin inside the pro-shop.
- UNDER no circumstances will weapons, drugs, and/or alcoholic beverages be permitted during any **NMAHA** event while on the premises of Blades Multi-Plex Arenas.
- Abusive and/or offensive behavior(s) to staff employees, coaches, referees, and other spectator(s) will never be tolerated. Those who choose to violate this policy will be immediately expelled from further events here at Blades Multi-Plex Arenas.
