SUBJECT: Baseball Try-outs for Select Team

The 2009 baseball season is underway and we had a very successful start this past weekend. Now is the time to take our game a step further and get ready for the post season. Unlike past seasons, we are getting our players prepared for the post season now by having them playing additional games along with their regular season ball games.

The Prince George's County Boys and Girls Club and Babe Ruth Baseball League is looking for baseball players and coaches who are interested in playing additional games on Sunday afternoons as a Select Team. All the players and coaches must play/coach league play to be eligible to participate on the Select teams. All rosters will be open so that players can try out for the team and play whenever they are available.

Coaches will select a maximum of 18 of their league's best players for the Select Team. The players will be added and deleted from the roster throughout Select League play. Another open tryout for all league players will take place at the end of the regular season play to compose an All-Star team. The All-Star team will represent Prince George's county in the District and State All-Star Tournaments to be held in July.

Tryouts for the 10, 12 and 13 year old divisions will be held at PGCBGC Sports Park, 13200 Woodmore Road, Mitchellville, MD on Sunday, May 3, 2009 from 2:00 PM until 5:00 PM. Ten year old (Minor League) tryouts will be held on field #3, Twelve year old (Major Leaguer) tryouts will be held on field # 2 and Thirteen year old (Prep) tryouts will be held on field #1. If you are interested in taking your game to the next stage and competing at a higher level, get your bat and glove and make your way to PGCBGC Sports Park on Sunday, May 3, 2009.

Select team coaches are also welcome to participate in the Select Team League. Jeff Tolson, Vincent Johnson, Doug Suhr, and Carlton Suber have agreed to get the league up and running but they are looking for other coaches to help them out.
