All applications must be complete and sent in its entirety in one package to the CJSA Office. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

1. Must be a dedicated soccer player and have played soccer with Connecticut Junior Soccer Association affiliated club.
2. Must have a C+ average or better and graduate High School in 2014.
3. Must plan on attending a school of higher education.
4. Must submit a **250-word essay** on What Soccer Means to Me. Essay must include at the top of page 1: Your Name, Address, Phone Number and Club Affiliation.
5. Application and essay must be received no later than March 1, 2014. Send to: Scholarship Committee, Connecticut Junior Soccer Association, 11 Executive Drive, Farmington, CT 06032.
6. Must be available for a personal interview with the Committee.
