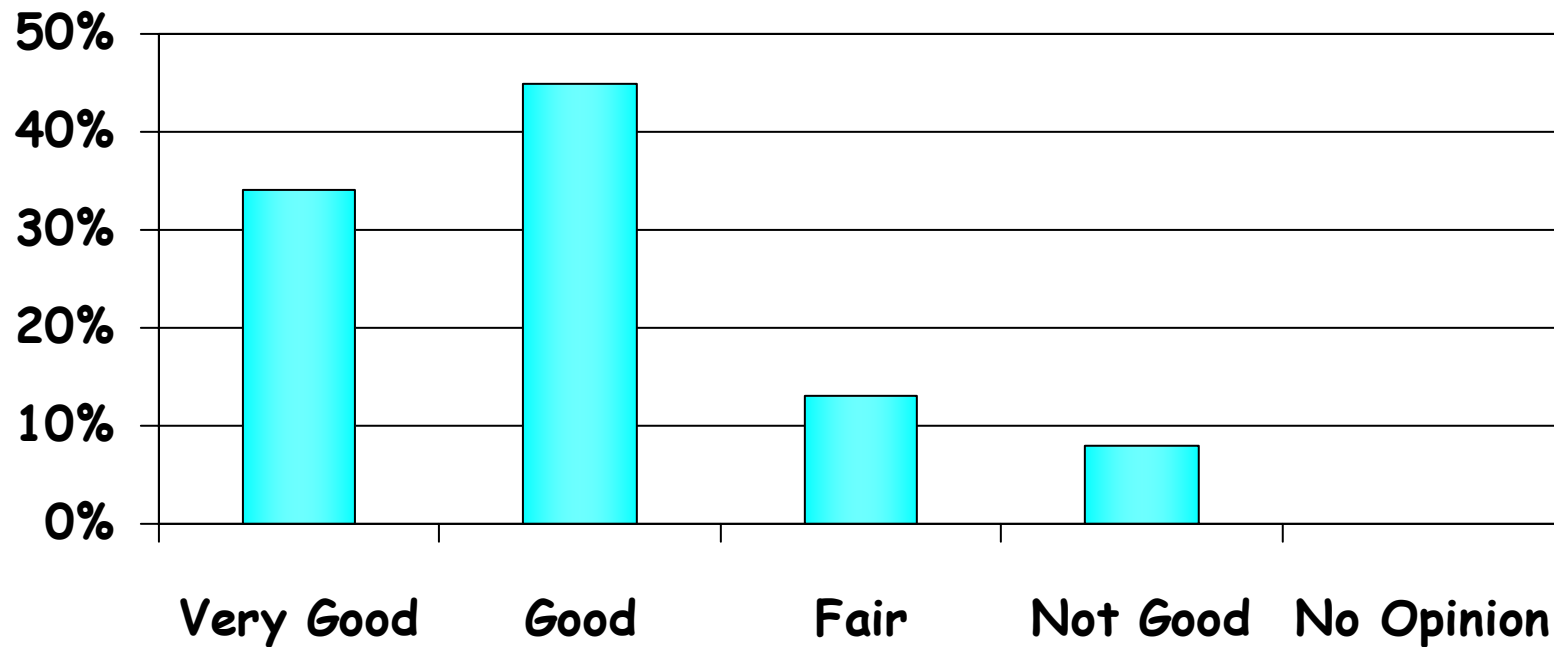


Background

- From 100 players, we received 38 responses.



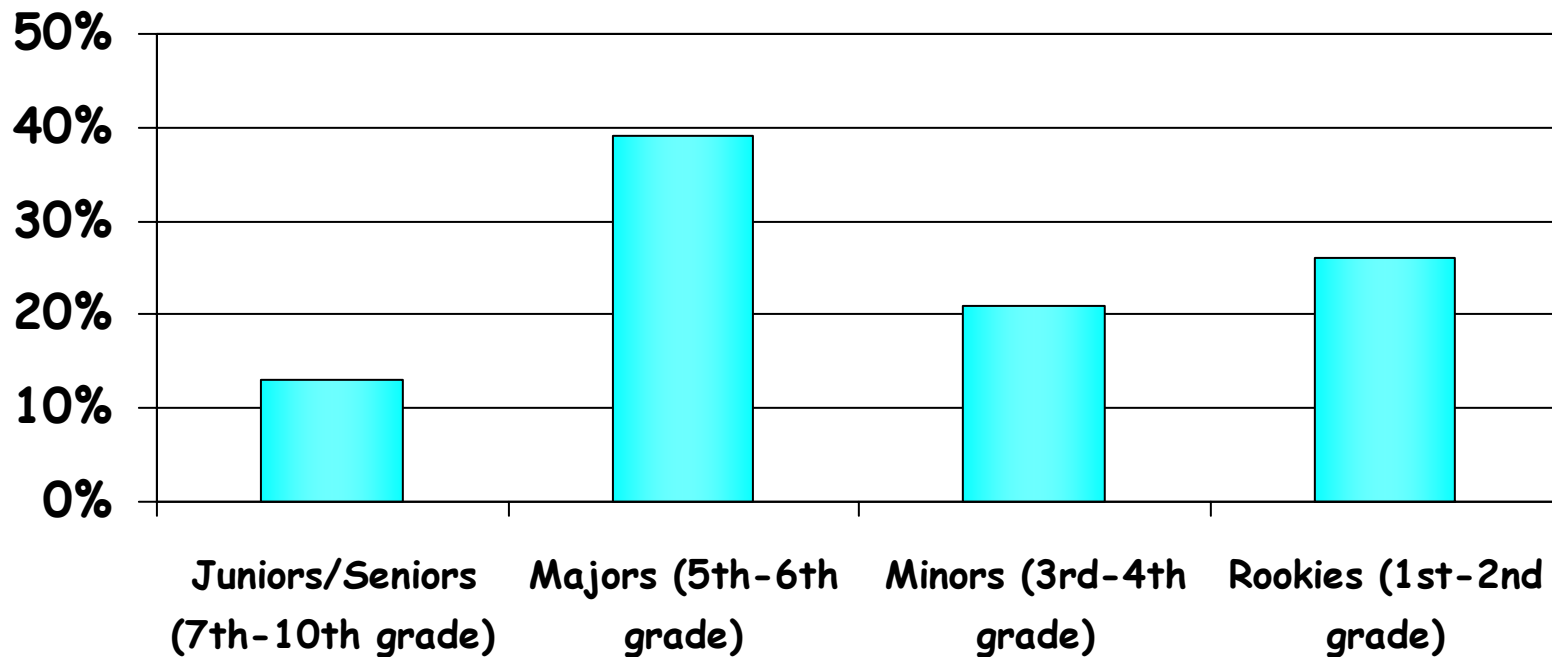

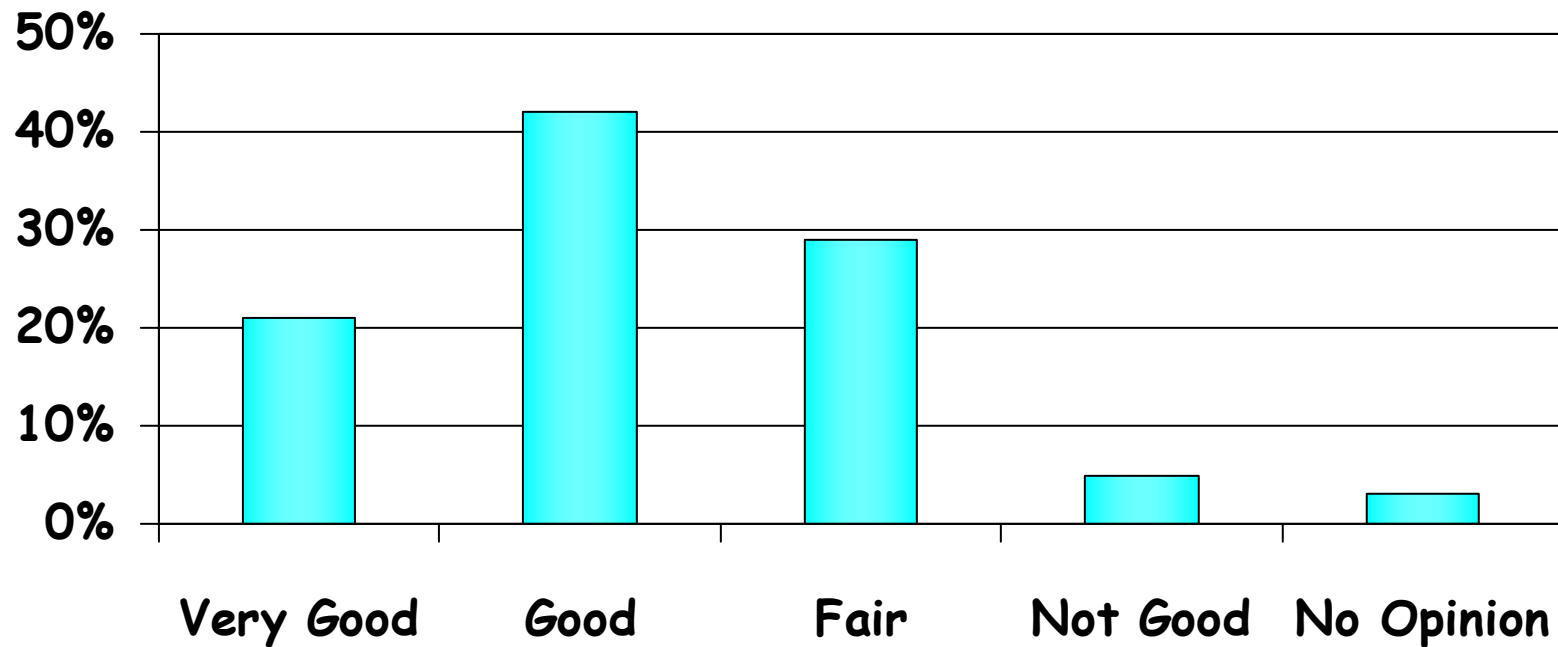
Representation across the leagues was adequate.

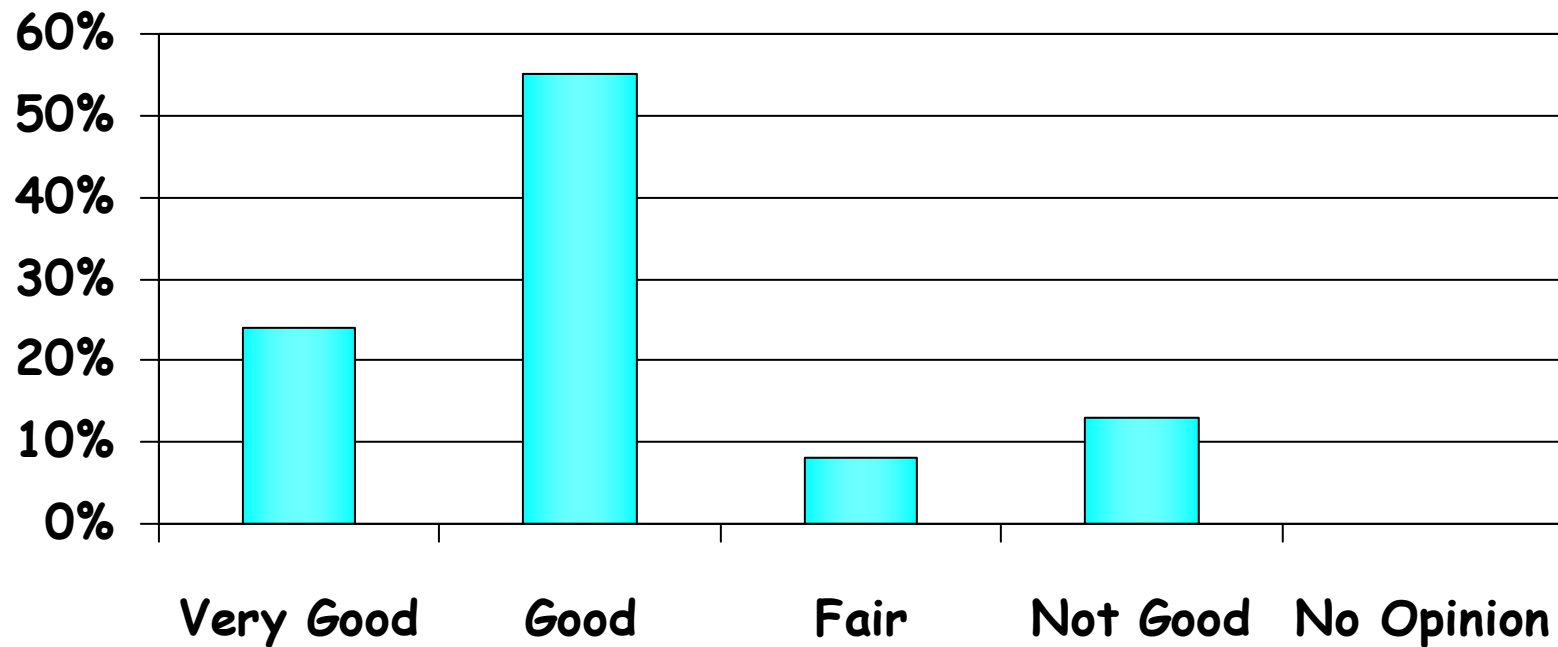
Competitive balance between the teams

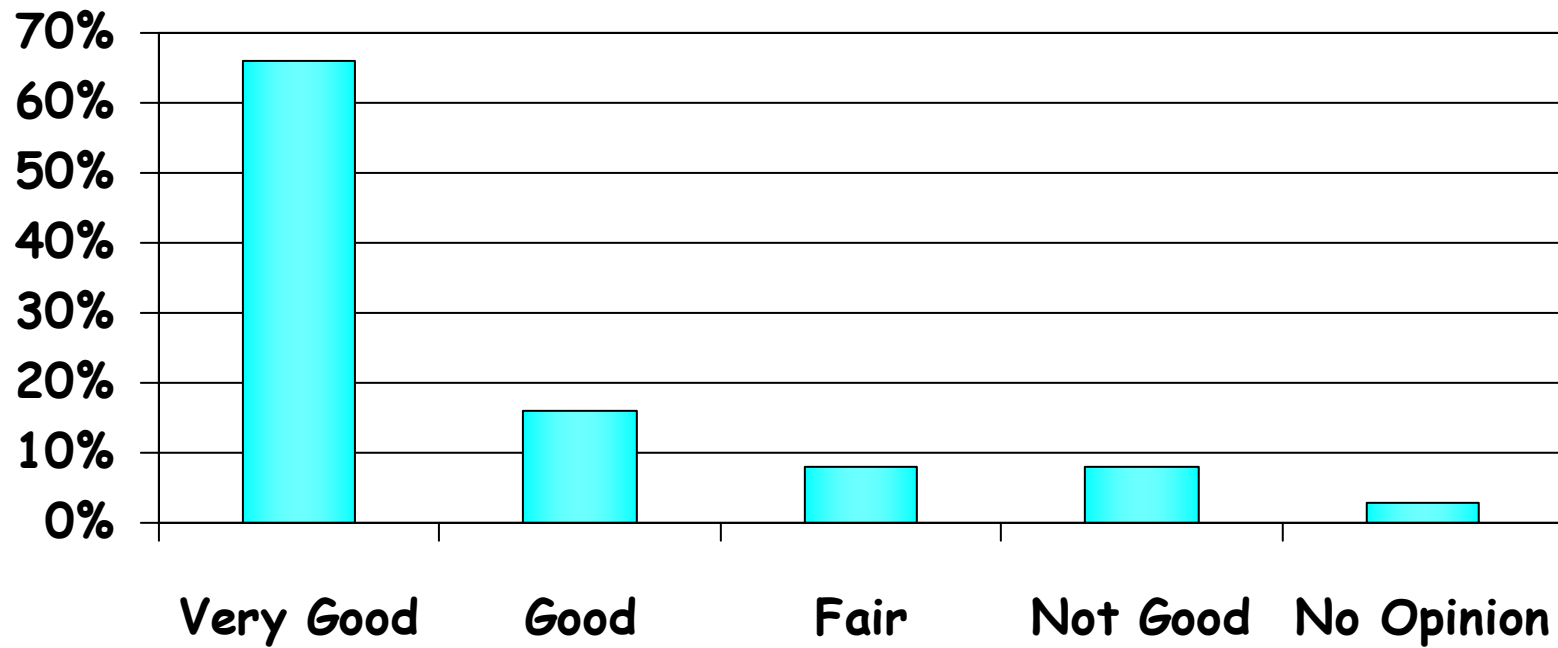
Pace of the games

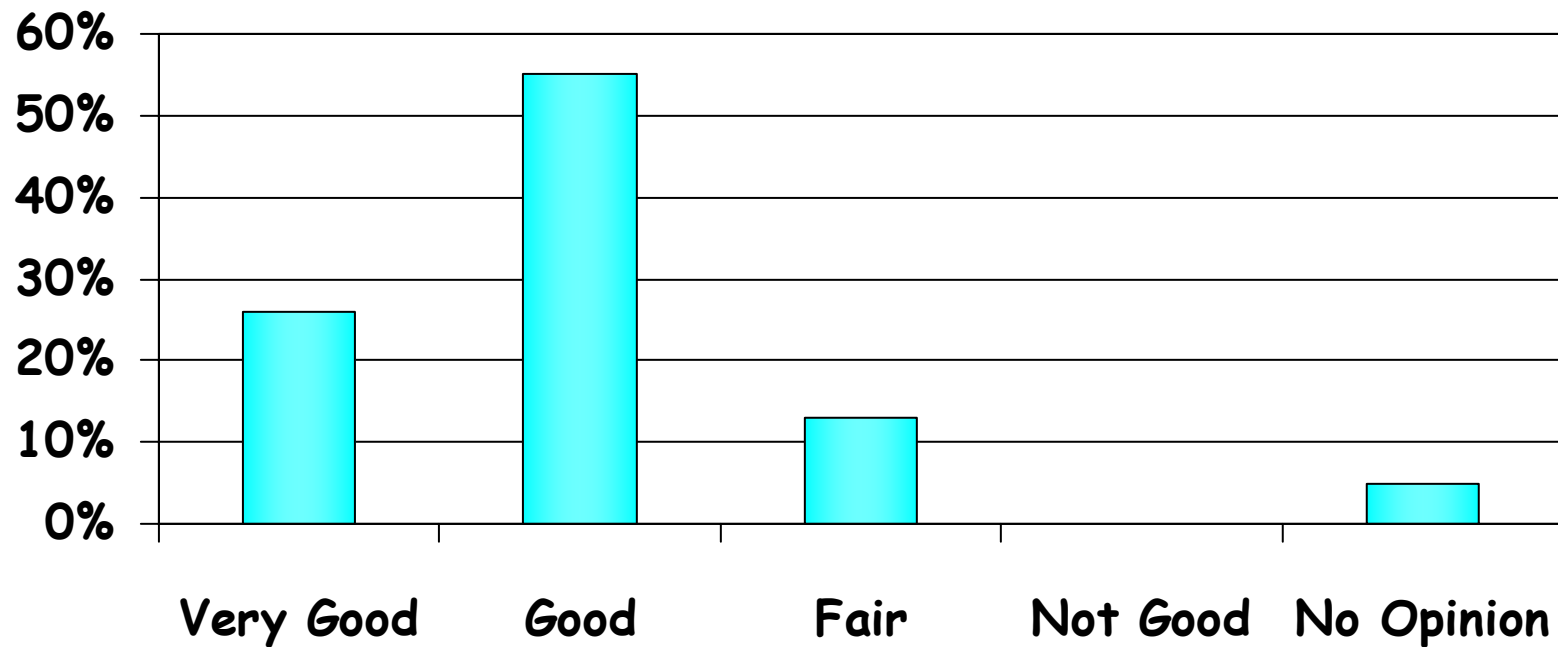

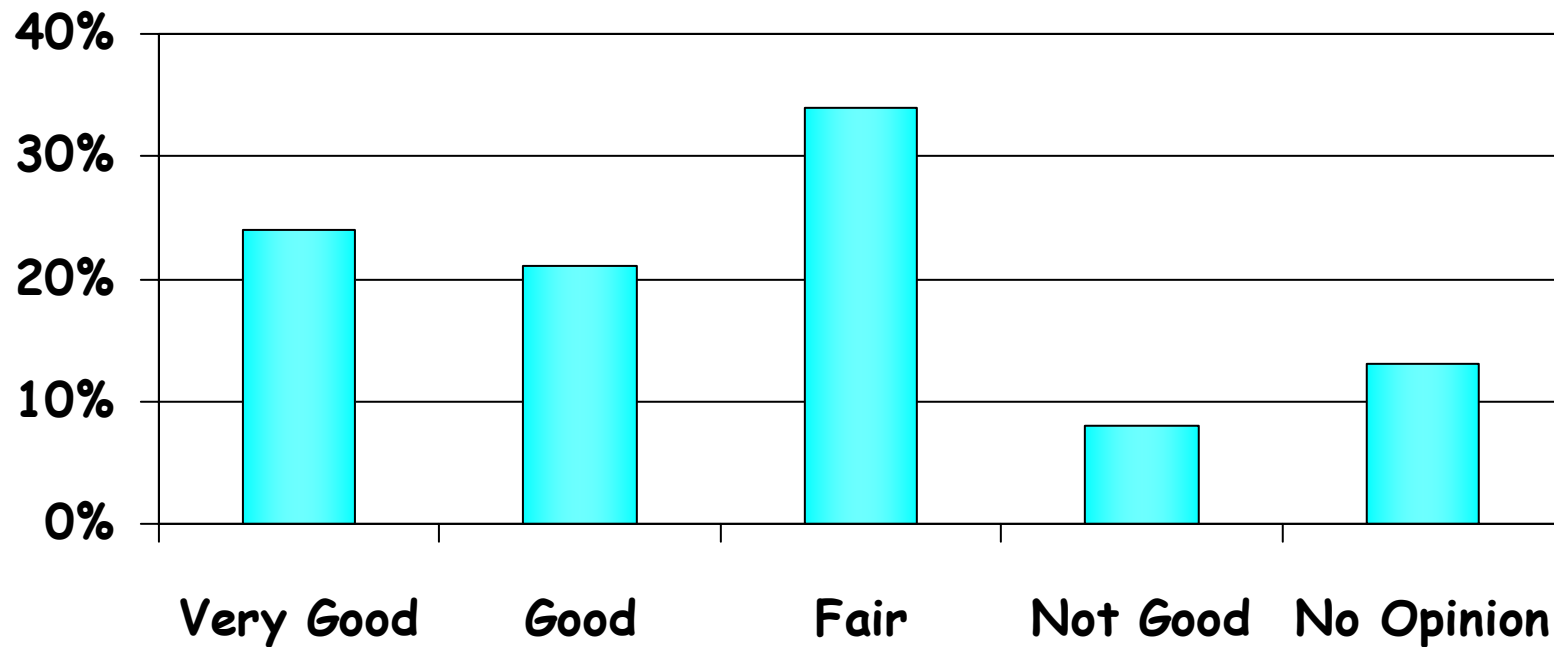


Equipment used for the games

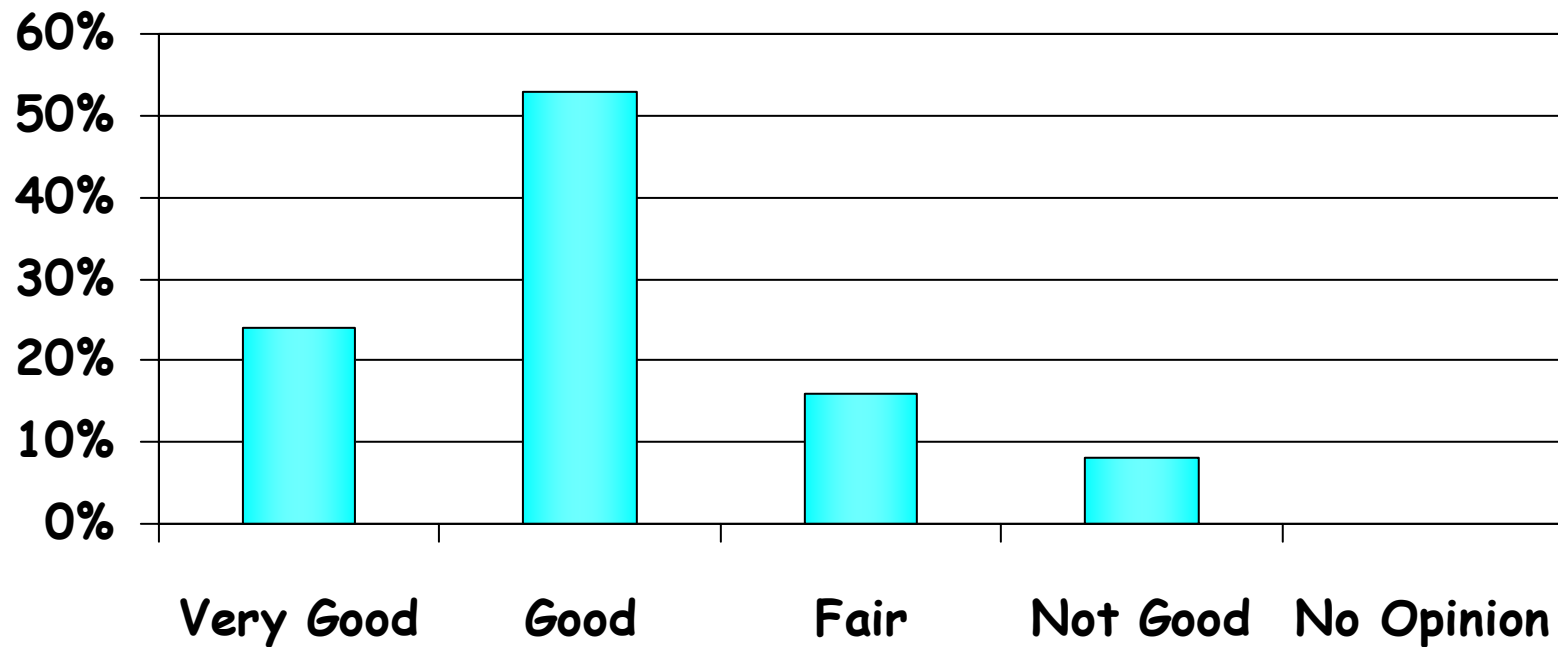

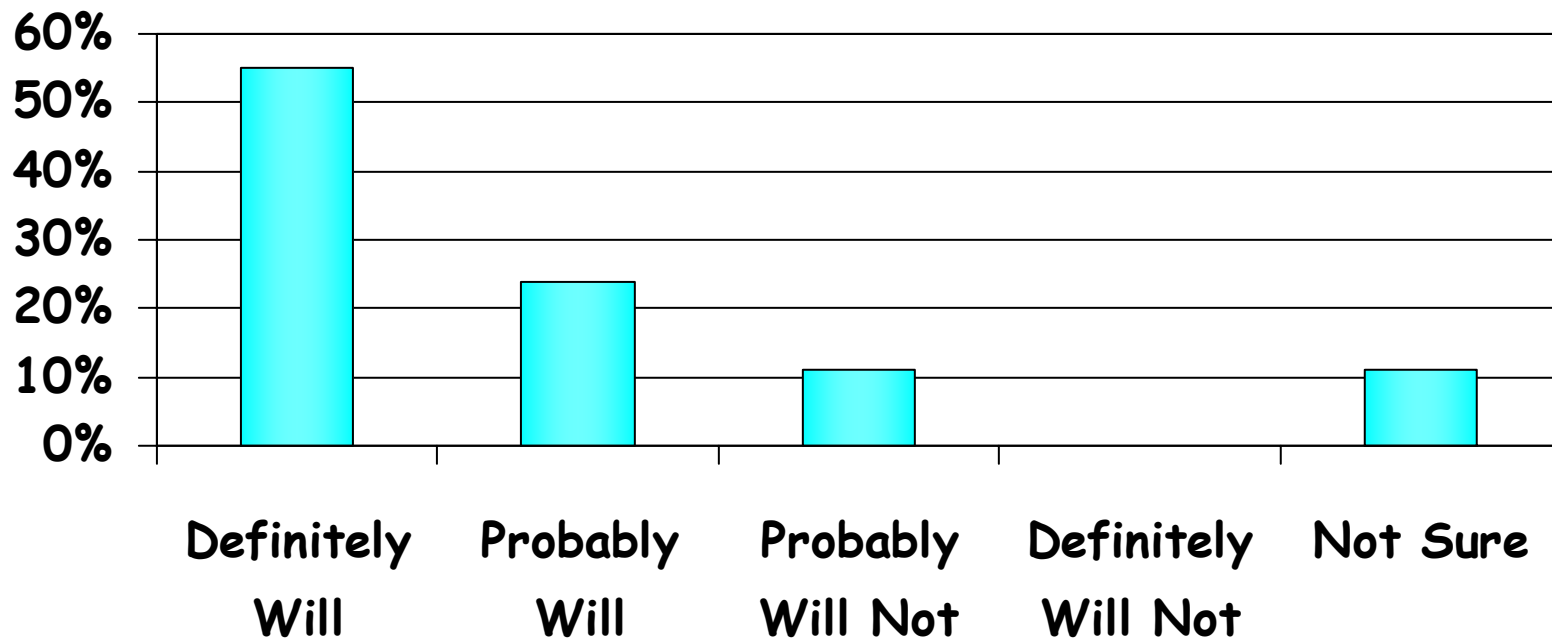
Development of my child's skills
