



OYA Girls Volleyball District 135 School Rules

Coaches:

Thank you for your time and support in making this organization a success. As we begin our basketball season, school district #135 has asked that we all abide by the following rules related to school behavior.

- OYA is not allowed in the schools until 10 minutes prior to our schedule time. Please show up at the gyms **ONLY** 10 minutes prior to your scheduled practice or game time and wait in the hall until the previous teams have finished their practice.
Coaches will need to be prepared to show pink contract to enter the schools. Please bring them in your equipment bag so you always have them ready.
- **NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES** are allowed in the gyms by Parents or siblings.
Players may have **ONLY CLEAR LIQUIDS INCLUDING CLEAR SPORT DRINKS**. Colored sport drinks will be confiscated.
- In case of spills, please notify the custodian immediately. This is to minimize the risk of an injury.
- Custodians will set up and pick up chairs. We are responsible for picking up our own mess.
- No ball bouncing in the halls! No running in the halls! Do not try and open lockers!
- No use of volleyballs or any other balls in either the halls or gyms by non-players.
- Coaches are responsible for all girls on their team during and after a game or practice. Coaches are not to leave any girl unattended. Stay with all girls until a parent or guardian has picked them up.
- Gyms will be scheduled through the OYA Girls program **ONLY**. Coaches are not to call either the school or the recreational department at the park district for gym time.
- No boys' teams are allowed to practice with any OYA Girls teams.
- All coaches (last game of the night) are required to check out with the custodian at the end of the night to make sure gyms and washrooms are in acceptable condition.

Please respect these rules set by District 135. Failure to do so may result in the OYA Girls program being banned from the school gyms in the future. Please respect the custodians, they all work very hard to assure our season runs smoothly and they are doing their job in keeping the schools in good shape.
