

RULES OF PLAY PEEWEE DIVISION

1. Division The PeeWee division will consist of 13-16 Coed Teams with a maximum of 7 players. We always try to keep the # of players to 6 if we have enough coaches.
 2. Practice To schedule a field for your practice day & time, please contact Mike Noble by e-mail: njbobafett@verizon.net You will only get one night during the week for practice.
- PLEASE NOTE – The FIRST 20 minutes of *every scheduled game* should be used for WARM-UP/PRACTICE. Games are scheduled hourly, but the actual game should not be started until 25 min past the hour. Use this as a 2nd weekly practice.
3. Length Each game will be made up of FOUR (4) 6-minute quarters. There will a 2-minute rest period between the 1st and 2nd quarters and the 3rd and 4th quarters. A 5-minute rest period will be between the 2nd and 3rd quarters. Goals will be changed between the 2nd and 3rd quarter.
 - NO SCORE WILL BE KEPT DURING PEEWEE GAMES.
 - A #3 Soccer Ball will be used in all PeeWee games.
 - Players must play equal amounts of time unless player says he/she doesn't want to play
 - There will be a 20 minute warm up practice prior to each game.
 - If a player is dominating the play, try to find ways to have them help other players
 4. Fielding Each Team will consist of 6 players for a 4 vs. 4 game. If a team does not have 4 players then the other team will play the same number of players.
 5. Rules: #1 HAVE FUN.
#2 Free Substitution at all times.
#3 Play may be interrupted so any coach can help teach the player(s) the correct technique in performing a skill. Play will also be interrupted for an injury.
#4 HAVE MORE FUN.
#5 There no penalties. If an issue arises, stop play, address it and restart play with a kick-in.
#6 Even though goals may be present, PLEASE DO NOT FOCUS THE PLAYERS ON SCORING GOALS as an objective. Coaches may use cones, balls, bags, shirts or what ever they choose to make additional goals or multiple goals around the field.
 6. Rain dates: If practices are rained out, there will be no make-up. If games are rained out, we will try to reschedule make-up games as scheduling permits. There is no guarantee that all games will be rescheduled.
 7. All restarts: Restarts are all "kick-ins"...no matter what the stoppage of play is other than injury. Modification of this rule is permitted please use common sense, except for injury restarts.
