**PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT**

Players of Team Elmhurst Soccer Club are to:

Exhibit excellent sportsmanship in every aspect of the game of soccer. This includes games, practices, meetings, and any other times the Club is being represented. There is to be no abusive or foul language, fighting, or heckling of officials, teammates, or players from the opposing team. Sportsmanship and respect for the opposition and officials must be shown regardless of the outcome of the game. Participation in the post-game handshake is mandatory.

Respect every player, opponent, coach, official, parent, and spectator at all times.

Dress appropriately for all practices and competitions. No torn or revealing clothing. TESC camp tees, soccer shorts and socks should be worn during practice sessions.

Be on time for practices and games.

Play fairly by the rules of soccer.

Try your best and work hard at all times.

Be modest winners and gracious losers.

Leave the field better than you found it. Clean up after yourself.

Players signing a player registration form are bound to that team for the entire seasonal year unless he/she requests a release. Players may be denied a release by the league office if the player is suspended by the team/club for club infractions, and/or owes club fees and equipment.



**PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT**

Parents of players of Team Elmhurst Soccer Club are to:

Be role models of excellent sportsmanship in every aspect of the game of soccer. This includes games, practices, meetings, and any other times the Club is being represented. There is to be no abusive or foul language, fighting, or heckling of players or officials.
