Parent Code of Conduct and Standards of Behavior

Sportsmanship

Everyone in the game, including the parents and spectators, should have a sense of fair play. Satisfaction for players, coaches, parents and spectators should come from watching athletes playing their hardest and doing their best. We need to applaud good plays by both our team and by members of the opposing team. The dictionary definition of sportsmanship is: sportsmanlike conduct, as fairness, courtesy, being a cheerful loser, etc.

Parents' and Spectators' Code of Conduct

- Be respectful of a participant by yelling at players, coaches, officials or other parents. By showing a positive attitude toward the game and all of its participants, the player will benefit.
- Refrain from the use of abusive, obscene or profane language or gestures.
- Know and study the rules of the game, and support the officials on and off the field. This approach will help in the development and support of the game. Any criticism of the officials only hurts the game and can result in a penalty to our team.
- Display good sportsmanship. Applaud a good effort in both victory and defeat, and enforce the positive points of the game. Act appropriately; do not taunt or disturb other fans; enjoy the game together. Cheer in a positive manner and encourage fair play; profanity and objectionable cheers or gestures are offensive and will not be permitted.
- Help provide a safe and fun environment; throwing any items on the field or in the stands can cause injury to players and officials. Be responsible for your own safety - be alert to prevent accidents from flying lacrosse balls and other avoidable situations.
- Respect the field as private areas for players, coaches and officials.
- Be supportive after the game – win or lose. Recognize good effort, teamwork and sportsmanship.
- Treat everyone fairly, regardless of gender, place of origin, color, sexual orientation, religion, political belief or economic status.

Responsibilities

Any parent or spectator violating the Code of Conduct and Standards of Behavior may be subject to a ban from attending Phantom lacrosse games (both home and away) for a specified or indefinite period of time based on a review and ruling by the Phantom Lacrosse coaches and the Board of Phantom Lacrosse Club.
