

2010 Player Sponsorship Scholarship

GLL is introducing an exciting new promotion for our families in 2010. Families are now able “pay” for their registration fees by obtaining business sponsorships for GLL.

This promotion is being introduced for several reasons.

- To provide families an opportunity to pay for their registration fees without cash during these tough economic times.
- To increase sponsorship revenues for the league.
- To increase the community business involvement in GLL.

There are several ways families can solicit obtain these sponsorships.

- Parents can sign up their business as a sponsor;
- Parents can request their employer sponsor a team for their child/family;
- Players/parents can solicit sponsorships from local businesses.

Ground rules of program:

- Soliciting family receives credit for one player’s registration fee (higher of \$75 or \$85 fees) for every individual sponsorship gained (\$395 or greater).
- Sponsorship applications can be completed online or by paper forms, both of which can be found at www.GeorgetownLL.com. The online Sponsorship application can be found on the top tabs and the paper form can be found in the Documents section on the left tabs of the homepage. The paper application can be mailed to: GLL Sponsorships, PO Box 553, Jenison, MI 49429. (Note that all sponsorship applications will be verified with the sponsoring business.)
- When registering your player, do not pay at the end of the registration process. Email registration@georgetownll.com to inform GLL of the sponsorship you’ve solicited to ensure the sponsorship form includes your child’s name and you receive credit.
- The player’s registration account will not be reimbursed until the sponsorship has been paid in full.
- If registration fees have already been paid, reimbursement will be made by:
 - Credit card if paid by credit card.
 - Check if paid by check or cash.
- Team sponsorships are distributed based on date/time sponsorship is **received** by GLL. If requested player’s team has already been requested by another sponsor, the latter sponsor has option of sponsoring a different team or receiving an outfield banner. Note that this will not be able to be determined until after team drafts have been completed.
- Teeball and Machine Pitch Divisions are sponsored as divisions. Therefore sponsors are not able to sponsor individual teams in these divisions.
- GLL reserves the right to refuse sponsorships from companies or individuals that do not meet the values of GLL or Little League in general.
- Sponsors must be new for 2010 with the exception of sponsors’ children. For future years, sponsors must be new with the exception of returning sponsor’s children or same soliciting player’s family.
