

Park Code of Conduct

- No pets allowed - For the safety of players and spectators pets are not allowed at Dale E. Wagner Park.
[Please note, service dogs aiding the impaired or disabled ARE ALLOWED in the park.](#) In the rare event that a service dog is out of control or exhibits behavior that threatens the health or safety of players or spectators, a league official will ask the owner to remove the dog from the premises.
- The use of alcohol or any tobacco products is strictly prohibited at the Georgetown Little League fields.
- No swearing - Please no profanity or vulgar language.
- No soft toss - Batting balls into the park fences will ruin the fence and is a potential safety hazard.
- No climbing fences.
- The speed limit in the park is 5 MPH. Please drive slow and watch out for children.
- No parking along 28th Avenue.
- Please do not litter, keep your park clean!
- **Please do** applaud effort on the field, regardless of the score. Remember that the league exists for the players to learn and to have fun. Even though baseball is competitive in nature, winning is of secondary importance.
- All disputes that are taken up with the umpire will be handled in a civil manner. Only managers may initiate such discussions with an umpire.
- Coaches will refrain from complaining about perceived bad calls to players and fans.
- Verbal abuse of an official, coach, player, or spectator, including obscene gestures, will not be tolerated.
