championships and three NCAA tournament semifinal appearances. With those accomplishments came three conference Coach of the Year honors and an Inside Lacrosse National Coach of the Year award. In his 9 years of coaching, Tucker has produced 16 All Americans, 22 All-Region players, and 26 All-Conference players.
