## VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

Parents and members of the Park City Ice Miners are one of our most important resources in creating a successful program for the athletes. As such, a “work deposit” policy has been established to provide a strong incentive to accomplish some of the more labor-intensive activities of the program.

Under this policy, athlete parents are expected to provide 10 hours per family of volunteer “work” at PCIM events during the year. In turn, 10 hours of parent volunteer support will retire the work deposit requirement of \$150 (6 hours, \$90 for mini-mite families). The work deposit hourly equivalent is \$15/hour. During the year, there are many opportunities to fulfill your “work deposit” requirement.

Families also may decide to make a \$150 donation (\$90 for mini-mite players) to the Park City Ice Miners which is a 501 (c) (3) tax non-profit tax exempt organization, and as such, all charitable contributions are tax deductible.
