With over 600 kids, the NMYBO program is the largest and most comprehensive basketball program in New Milford.

The in-town leagues are for players interested in participating in a highly instructional program. The program has developed rules, policies, and practices to make each player's experience in the program a positive one. The in-town program (grades 4-5 & 6- 7-8) has practices and games during the week. Grades K-3 meet on Saturdays, and the session consists of skills and drills followed by a game.

The travel program is a competitive basketball league which has the local New Milford players competing against area town teams. The team practices 2-3 times a week and plays games both home and away each weekend. **Additional fees are required for participation in the travel program.**

Any players trying out and not making the travel team will automatically be placed into the appropriate in town league.

All registrations (In town and Travel) require a completed and signed application, signed liability waiver form/code of conduct and a registration fee. **Participants in the travel program will require additional costs at a later time.**
