FAQ'S

What are the Fury All Stars?

The Fury All Stars consist of players who have participated in the FGSA spring season. They are looking for an opportunity to play at a higher level against more advanced competition without the long term time and financial commitments required by the FGSA tournament teams (Fusion teams).

How many Fury All Star teams are there?

There are four: 8U, 10U, 12U, 18U.

What is the difference between the Fury All Stars and the Fusion tournament teams?

The Fury All Star teams are composed of players who participated in the FGSA spring season. They are fully funded by the FGSA and only play in a couple of local tournaments. The Fusion tournament teams are full time travel teams. They are responsible for their own fundraising, scheduling, etc. The Fusion teams require a much larger time and financial commitment and interested players must try out for a roster spot on a Fusion team.

When are the games?

The Fury All Stars will play in two tournaments. Both take place after the regular spring season and both are in June.

What is the cost for my daughter to participate?

There is no financial cost to play for the Fury. The FGSA supplies the uniforms (shirt, shorts, socks) and pays for the two June tournaments. If a Fury team chooses to play in additional tournaments, the team (i.e. parents) would be responsible to pay the entry fee.

What is the time commitment?

Fury All Star teams usually start practicing after the spring season ends in June though some may start earlier. As the teams only have 1-2 weeks to prepare for their first tournament, they may practice anywhere from 2-4 times a week. The number of practices and the nights they would be held is up to each manager.

How are the teams selected?

Players who are interested in participating must first complete a commitment form. This form can be found on the FGSA website and must be turned in by May 9. The managers of each division will then meet with the Fury All Star director to select the team. Each team must send a representative (manager, assistant coach) to this meeting to ensure

that all teams are represented. The coaches will then vote on the players who have submitted commitment forms and fill the team.

How will the players be notified if they have made a Fury All Star team?

The manager of each age group will contact the players who were selected to confirm that they are still interested in participating.

How much playing time will my daughter get if she plays for the Fury?

Playing time will be determined by the manager. Unlike the regular season, there is no guaranteed playing time on the Fury.

How are the managers selected?

Managers who are interested in coaching the Fury All Star team in their age group will notify the Fury All Star director in writing by April 19. If more than one manager expresses interest, the Fury All Star director will decide who the manager will be by whatever criteria he/she feels will help select the best applicant. The FGSA board will then review the list submitted by the Fury All Star director of the managers he/she have decided are the best applicants for each age group.

What nights will the Fury All Star teams practice? Where will they practice?

Practice nights and locations will be up to each Fury coach to decide. Their choices are subject to availability.
