REGISTRATION PROCESS  
*Please Read Carefully!!*

**NEW PLAYERS TO THE LEAGUE**

The player's parent/guardian must go to the In Person Registration and bring **3 documents** to prove Residency within our district. The following documents are acceptable for this purpose:  
Drivers License, Voter Registration Card, School Records, Welfare Records, Federal/State/Local Records, Support Payment Records, Homeowners/Renters Insurance Card, Utility Bill, Medical Records, Vehicle Records, Internet/Cable/Satellite Records, Support Payment Records, Financial/Loan Records.

The parent/guardian must also provide for inspection an original Birth Certificate issued by federal, state, or provincial registrars of vital statistics, or local offices thereof. This document must have been issued within 30 days of the birth of the child. Not acceptable as sole proof of birth are Baptismal Certificates, Certificates of Blessing, hospital certificates or photocopied records.

**The In-Person Registration is held at the Stamford Baptist Church on High Ridge Road on the following dates & times:**

Thursday, February 25<sup>TH</sup> 2010 7:00 pm — 9:00 p.m.  
Thursday, March 4<sup>TH</sup> 2010 7:00 pm - 9:00 p.m.  
Saturday, March 6<sup>TH</sup> 2010 9:00 am — 12:00 p.m.

Please bring the following to the In-Person Registration:

- 1) Completed "2010 STAMFORD AMERICAN LITTLE LEAGUE REGISTRATION FORM"
- 2) Three documents to prove residency within our district
- 3) An original Birth Certificate
- 4) A check made out to "Stamford American Little League" for the Registration Fee based upon the division for which you are registering your child.

**RETURNING PLAYERS TO THE LEAGUE**

*If you have not moved since last season*, there are three ways in which to register your player:

- 1) complete the enclosed registration form and mail it back with the appropriate Registration Fee (check made out to "Stamford American Little League") to:

*If you have moved* and wish to remain in our league, we need 3 NEW proof of residency documents. Please follow the instructions above for new players to the league and come to the In-Person Registration. You do not need to bring a birth certificate.

\*Placement on an AAA or Majors team is through the tryout and draft process.

**TRYOUTS AND DRAFT PROCESS:**

Tryouts for placement on either an AAA or Majors team will take place on Sunday March 14<sup>th</sup> at the **TURN OF RIVER MIDDLE SCHOOL.**

8 and 9 year olds – 8:00-9:30AM

10, 11, and 12 year olds - at 9:30-11:00 AM

If for some reason your child cannot make this tryout, *please notify Larry Miller @ 203-324-7452 no later than March 10.*

The tryout will consist of throwing, fielding, hitting and running. Players will be placed into small groups and led through a demonstration of their baseball skills by an adult. SALL AAA and Majors coaches will rate each player on these skills in order to determine a ranking for draft purposes. The ratings and rankings are not shared with individual players or their parents/guardians.

Players ages 8 — 11 are eligible for the AAA Division and players 10 —12 are eligible for the Major Division. If the parent of a child who is 10 or 11 does not wish to have their child participate in the Majors, please inform us of this when you check-in at the tryouts.

**Players who try out are not guaranteed a spot in the Division of their choice.**
