I. Secretary's Report: We did not have the minutes from the previous meeting to review, They will be reviewed in the next meeting.

II. Treasurer's Report: Total brought in for 2015 was \$183,593.00. Cash out for 2015 was 169,546. 2015 Net cash flow was \$14,047.

Total deposits made in January was \$4,510.57. We received \$8500 in December from TNT (prepaid for 2016). A transfer of Women's League balance \$3000 was put in the General Account. January payments to be made was \$4,000.00 (loan). Balance in General Fund after these deposits and checks is \$18,374.63.

Matt Caputo motioned to approve the Treasurer's report and Eric Medlin 2nd. All approved.

III. Calendar Updates:

- Clinic dates at Strayer Middle School set for January 15th, January 29th, and March 11th. PA Panthers 14U will run the clinic on January 15th. Matt Caputo will contact Bill Smith to see if the 12U PA Panthers can run the Clinic on January 29. March 11 was TBD was considered to be a Coach Clinic.

Clinic times will be TBall/Rookies 6-7:20pm. Minors/Majors 7:30-9:00pm.

A 10-minute space will help with the transition. Bill Coblentz suggested that the players for the travel teams join in with the Minors/Majors group because of similar ages. They can help coach the TBall/Rookies group. Sunday Select practices scheduled for the same times as the clinic will be cancelled so the girls can attend the clinics as a group.

Eric Medlin will post the dates on the website and also send out notifications on the clinic dates.

Bill Coblentz suggested looking into having a catcher/pitcher clinic to work with both positions - Perhaps combining the current pitching lessons with catcher lessons. Matt Caputo will search for space and also a catcher coach interested in running the clinic.

IV. Spring Rec

- Current registration for the 2016 Spring season is at 52. 14 are unpaid. All Sunday Select players in 10U and 12U are registered to for the spring rec season.
- Unpaid players must pay to receive a uniform
- A late fee will be charged for those unpaid after the deadline
- Spring Registration forms should be available to parents at the open clinics.
- Bill is working with Ray Fox to determine Walk-In Registration dates at Dairy Queen.
- Eric will update the website to include the new Coaches Code of Conduct.

- Bill is requiring a new Vet Park safety policy that will ban all scooters/Skateboards/Bikes/etc from the four lower fields. Signs will be made and posted throughout the park in the restricted areas.

V. New Business

- Charging \$5 for parking at all tournaments in 2016. We will get tickets made with sponsors offering coupons to local businesses. Signs will be made indicating what the fees are going towards (bathrooms, field maintenance/improvements). There will be different phases of a 4-5 year plan. PA Panthers players will not have to pay for parking. They will be given special passes to keep in their car.
- Bill is working on adding another row of parking blocks
- Jose is getting computer systems to help the flow of orders and minimize lines at the snack stand.
- Matt is planning a travel teams meeting to coordinate and organize the upcoming season.
- Matt and Eric are working together on launching a PA Panthers website.
