### III. President's Report:

- It has been a rough tournament season. The first full 2 day tournament did not happen until 6/16. Jen Knoll will come in a clean the restrooms for the tournaments.
- TNT prep will begin 6/26/18, Tuesday, by removing the bask stop pads, adding lines to the parking lot, and weeding/general clean up. The TNT clinic will be 6/27/18. There are 175 teams this year and they will be using fields from DeSales to Harleysville. The extra dumpster has been ordered. We need to use Milford field since we can't use Memorial Park due to a concert.

#### **IV. Vice President's Report**

- Pa Panther's website needs to be updated. All the info is from 2017. Matt has a meeting with both George and John about the U14 try-outs. They are working to coordinate dates that will be close but not over-lapping.
- Summer Clinic-Meg Klee will run the clinic. So far 41 kids are registered and only 2 are unpaid. The clinic is charging \$50 per and the money will all go to RASA. A current player's grandmother printed all the flyers up for us and the college players came back during rec games to hand out the flyers. The 1<sup>st</sup> day was inside the 6<sup>th</sup> grade center's gym due to weather. The snack stand was open 11-1 for the clinic. There was a small problem the 3<sup>rd</sup> day when they only had 2 coaches.
- Rec League went well. There was only one complaint on the survey that was sent out.

#### **V. Old Business**

- Sponsors and Billboards- St Lukes and Mike Augustino will both be offered to sponsor Fall Ball for \$750. The first one to respond will be the sponsor. Bill will offer St Lukes to sponsor the scoreboards. Bill is working with VerizonSigns to replace the scoreboards.
- Quakertown Community Day (7/4)-we have a 12x12 space. We need help to man the booth and to help volunteer time in the food tents.
- Buffalo Wild Wings- Paul asked that we add their logo to our sponsor scroll on the website. They are giving us 10% of sales with every "teammate card" that is shown. The card will be placed on the website and Facebook.
- Sponsors-Paul asked the sponsors be added to the Facebook page.

#### **VI. New Business**

- Alexis Quay-we will add a memorium note on the Website. Will look at the possibility of a scholarship in the future.
- Walmart Bucket Drop-this event will have to be canceled since we could not get any support from the rec league.
- Fall Ball-Tball will be free. We need head coaches. Possibly rotate assistant coaches in with one head coach. Also need to rotate the fields so that the tball/rookies are not always in the outfield. Will try to get the High School players to help. Need to look into being able to hand out flyers at LifeSpan. Try to get it onto the QNB website. Matt will look into getting it on the electronic billboard at the intersection of 313 & 309. Also need to put in Penny Power.
- Magnets/Clings-Paul is working on getting a proof approved and ordered.
