- **PRIOR BALANCES** must be paid prior to registering for the 2018 spring season. Questions regarding outstanding balances may be directed to hslreg@gmail.com
- **MEDICAL FORMS** (available online) **must** accompany players on the first day of clinic/practice in order to practice.
- **BIRTH CERTIFICATES** must be presented for review for any player not previously registered in Clinton Little League.
- **UNIFORM SIZES** must be updated. We order uniforms based on the sizes YOU enter online.

Schedule

The Spring Baseball and Softball schedule runs from April 1st through the middle of June. In early June, District Tournament Teams will be selected by League Officials to participate as All-Stars, which will begin immediately following regular season playoffs and terminate when the team is eliminated from contention. Registrations for summer ball will open in May and fall baseball registrations will open in July.

- **OPENING DAY** is Saturday, April 28th (rain date Sunday, April 29th) - Parade, Photos, Ceremony and Games.

Player Assessments and Formation of Teams

Teams will be formed through a clinic-style player assessment process which will occur in March for all divisions except Peewees. When forming teams, the League's objective is to develop equally competitive teams in each Division. League Officials will form teams based primarily on player's skills with the objective to form balanced teams.

Players seeking to play in the next higher division will be evaluated based on many skill factors. For instance, a League Age 10-year old is eligible to try out for the Majors Division, however may not "make the cut" based on the skill assessment of the League's Player Agents/Representatives. Team size and total number of registered players will also be a factor. All players will be eligible to play in the next division if they do not make the higher division.

The actual dates, times and locations will be determined at a later date and shown on the website. Parents of eligible **registered and paid** players will be notified of the exact time to attend immediately after registration is closed. Players **must wear sneakers** and bring their glove. Please do not bring any bats. If you do, they will be taken and returned at the end of the session.
