### PLAYER EXPECTATIONS

Below is a list of expectations, or assumptions, of the players in the Spencerport Soccer Club. Players are:

1. To adhere to the Code of Conduct and Team Rules.
2. Demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times.
  - a. To demonstrate self-control - win and lose graciously.
  - b. To avoid actions that could offend others – treat others the way you would like to be treated.
  - c. To keep cheering positive – encourage teammates.
  - d. To remember that everyone is human and will make mistakes. No faulting team members, coaches or officials.

### PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

While a registered member of a SSC team:

1. I will conduct myself in a manner that shows respect for my teammates, coaches, officials, opposing teams, parents and spectators.
2. If I am found to be using, or in possession, of illicit drugs or alcohol I will be removed from the SSC.
3. I recognize that my parents or guardians will bear the responsibility of any financial obligation due to my infraction(s).
4. I recognize that I will not be allowed to play in either SSC practices or games until all financial obligations have been settled. Unless under appeal.
5. I recognize that in the event my parents or guardians refuse to pay financial obligations; NYSW will ban me from playing club soccer in NY State.

## PARENT/GUARDIAN/SPECTATOR EXPECTATIONS

Below is a list of expectations, or assumptions, of the parents, guardians and spectators of players in the Spencerport Soccer Club. Parents are:

1. To support the efforts of the players, coaches and officials in a positive manner by modeling the behavior we expect from our children.
  - a. To avoid actions that could offend others – treat others the way you would like you and your children to be treated.
  - b. To keep cheering positive – appreciate good play from both teams.
  - c. To remember that everyone at SSC is a volunteer.
  - d. To remember that everyone is human and will make mistakes.
2. To support the decisions of the coach and officials. Let the coaches coach, the players play, and the officials officiate.
3. Learn the rules of the game so as to be a better informed spectator.
4. Volunteer at some point of the year to contribute directly to the team or indirectly to the club

## PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I will conduct myself in a manner that shows respect for my child's teammates, coaches, officials, opposing teams, parents and spectators.
2. I will limit my conduct to positive support while at games (cheering) and positive support of the coaching staff.
3. I will be responsible for the behavior of guests who have come to observe my children.
  - a. I will make the guests aware of behavior expectations.
  - b. In the event the guest (s) incur disciplinary action. I am responsible for any financial obligation due to this, as listed below.
4. I recognize that I will bear the responsibility of any financial obligation due to my infraction(s) or my child's infraction (s).
5. I recognize that *all family members* will be suspended from play in either SSC practices or games until all financial obligations have been settled. Unless under appeal.
6. I recognize that refusal to pay financial obligations will be result in NYSW banning my children from playing club soccer in New York State.
