

Time Keeping and Clock Operation

The following information is outlined in the 2013-2014 CHC Rules and Procedures document maintained on the CHC website.

ARTICLE VI Playing Rules

The current edition of the official USA Hockey Playing Rules shall be used for all games played by CHC member program teams. A USA Hockey sanctioned game is defined as:

A game is a match played against another team which is registered with USA Hockey or a member organization of the IIHF of the same competitive level and officiated by registered officials. A game shall consist of at least three (3) periods (or the equivalent, see USA Hockey rules & Regulations XII. Q. Time of Periods), except where the game is interrupted, (by some unforeseen event) after two (2) periods have been completed

Length of Periods:

For games between tournament teams, the length of periods will not be less than 10 minutes, stop time, for Mites and Squirts, with the recommended length of periods being 12 minutes, stop time. For games between PeeWee, Bantam, and Midget tournament teams, the length of periods shall be as set forth by USA Hockey Rules & Regulations and listed herein.
