Plymouth Youth Hockey's Policy on Helmets for Coaches

In Accordance with USA Hockey's policy on Coaches wearing Helmets:

USA Hockey is requiring all ice hockey coaches and instructors of registered USA Hockey youth/high school, disabled, girls'/women's 19 & under and below programs to properly wear ice hockey helmets during all on-ice sessions, including practices, controlled scrimmages and coach and referee clinics (seminars).

All Plymouth Youth Hockey coaches and Instructors will be required to wear an acceptable Hockey Helmet during all ice sessions as stated by USA Hockey. Head Coaches will be responsible for the enforcement of this policy with their coaching staff.

Plymouth Youth Hockey has placed the following enforcement of the Hockey USA Coaches wearing Helmets Requirement:

First Offense:

Coach will be given a Verbal warning from the Plymouth Youth Hockey Board of Directors

Second Offense:

Coach will be given a written warning from the Plymouth Youth Hockey Board of Directors

Third Offense:

The offending coach will be immediately suspended by the Plymouth Youth Hockey Board of Directors. The coach will need to appear before the Plymouth Youth Hockey Disciplinary committee for further review, and will not be able to return to coaching until said meeting takes place.

All Coaches will be required to read and sign this agreement, accepting that they understand the described Policy and Enforcement.
