***Road to new officials certification:***

1. **Sign up online** – <http://nclra.arbitersports.com/front/102436/Registration>
2. **Sign up with US Lacrosse and register (or renew) your membership**

(be sure your membership designation includes OFFICIAL)
3. **Pay registration fee of \$75 and the annual dues of \$65** by either using your credit/debit card through PayPal, the link is on our website at **Northern California Lacrosse Referees Association** . You will be a member.
4. **Read the rule book and mechanics manual** (which you will receive end of November / early December)
5. **Attend (2) Level 1 clinics** (1 classroom + dry on field training) and (1 classroom + live on field training) – you will be assigned to a specific location
6. **Purchase uniform**
7. **Take and pass online test with a minimum score of 80%**
