

NVWF Code of Conduct

The NVWF Code of Conduct is strict and serious in our sport. All people associated with the sport are always expected to act with sportsmanship, dignity and respect for others. This includes coaches, parents, wrestlers and referees.

Poor sportsmanship includes:

- Arguing with coaches, officials, teammates, opponents or spectators
- Using threatening or profane language
- Baiting or taunting coaches, officials, teammates, opponents or spectators
- Unsafe play
- Uncontrolled behavior on and off the mat.

Poor sportsmanship will carry, at a minimum, the following consequences:

First Offense	Verbal warning
Second Offense	Dismissal from meet
Third Offense	Dismissal from meet and next meet
Fourth Offense	Dismissal from NVWF

We, parent(s) and wrestler, have discussed the NVWF Code of Conduct and agree to abide by it. We understand that there is no refund or recourse for dismissal from our program as a consequence of breaking this Code of Conduct.
