

## PLEASE NOTE:

**US Lacrosse recently updated their registration system. This has resulted in some members encountering difficulties when renewing their membership.**

**The tips listed below should help with some of the pitfalls that exist in the LA/USL integration, specifically those stemming from situations when differing data is entered in the US Lacrosse and Edmond Lacrosse sites.**

- If you were brought to the USL site, it means that your membership is expiring before the end of the spring season and it will need to be renewed.
- **Ignore the fact if it says "membership is active and has not expired" and please go ahead and renew.**
- Once USL renewal/registration is complete, close the USL window and continue registration on the EDMOND LACROSSE CLUB (ELC) website. The ELC registration page should have remained open in the background. If it has not, please reopen the ELC registration page and proceed with player's registration.
- Once back in the ELC site, if a message pops up in red at the top of the page referencing that the member number doesn't match records with USL, scroll down on member's profile to the line item that lists the member's USL number. If that field has a number, please delete it. Click Submit and you should now be able to proceed with player's registration.
- Birthdates in the ELC database and USL's database must match. Many times there is either an incorrect birthdate in either the ELC site or the US Lacrosse system. If the two birthdates are inconsistent, USL generates a second number for your child, which will create difficulty registering on our system.
- Please call USL at **410-235-6882** where they can confirm the correct information and then deactivate the old membership number. If the birthdate is incorrect in the ELC system, please email us at **info@edmondlacrosse.com** and we can make the correction from our end.
- If you are renewing more than one child with USL, close the USL window after the first child has been renewed. We have found that some of our members who are renewing two or more family members think they have renewed all and haven't. Only the first was renewed. To avoid this, USL recommends closing windows between renewals.
