

**WETHERSFIELD LITTLE LEAGUE
PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT**



Wethersfield Little League has implemented the following Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents must read, understand and sign this form prior to their children participating in our league.

Any parent guilty of improper conduct at any game or practice will be asked to leave the sports facility and minimally will be suspended from the following game. Repeat or severe violations will cause a multiple game suspension for the parent, or cause the parent to forfeit the privilege of attending games for the season. All sanctions are at the discretion of the Wethersfield Little League Board of Directors.

By signing below, I agree to the following:

1. I will treat all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with dignity and respect in language, attitude, behavior, and mannerisms
2. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field.
3. I will give only encouragement and applaud only positive accomplishments whether for my child, his/her teammates, their opponents or the officials.
4. I will never demonstrate threatening or abusive behavior, use foul language or profanity, or make obscene gestures, or engage in any inappropriate behavior or conduct, at any time.
5. I will respect my child's coach and support his/her efforts. I will not instruct from the sidelines unless asked to by the coach.
6. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
7. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
8. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all League events.
9. I will help my child to learn the right lessons from winning and losing and from individual accomplishments and mistakes.
10. I will be responsible to report to any perceived misconduct by coach, player, parent or official so it can be dealt with in the appropriate manner.
11. I will place the emotional and physical well being of the participants ahead of any personal desire to win.
12. I will be responsible for my own behavior and that of my family and guests.
