PLAYER CALL-UP POLICY

- A. A call-up list needs to be created by the manager of every team within their age bracket. The manager should recommend 2-3 players from their own team to be called up that have the ability to play at a higher level. Before a player is placed on the call-up list, the coach must get approval from the player's parent(s).
- B. Only the older players within an age bracket are allowed to be called up. For instance, 10 year olds in Minors can be called up to Majors. 12 year olds in Majors can be called up to Juniors, etc. If an exception needs to be made this needs prior approval by the Commissioner.
- C. Travel players that also choose to play in the House League are eligible to be called up as long as they meet the age criteria set forth above in Rule B.
- D. Travel players that choose not to play in the House League are not eligible to be called up to a higher level within the House League without Commissioner prior approval.
- E. Any player that is called up and plays for a team at a higher level is not allowed to pitch or catch. Also, they must bat last in the lineup.
- F. If a player is called up and the team they are playing for has the minimum number of players, the call up player should still participate in the game. This includes playing both the infield and outfield positions as well as required to sit one of the innings.
