

# **RUSH HENRIETTA ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION**

## **EJECTION/DISCIPLINE POLICY**

### **Manager/Coach Ejected**

Any Manager or coach who is ejected by an umpire during any scheduled (i.e. Regular Season, Playoffs, All-Star game, etc.) game will be required to sit out the next scheduled game. The manager will turn over his/her duties to an NYSCA certified coach for the duration of the one game suspension. The manager or coach cannot be present at this game.

### **Player Ejected**

Any RHAA player who is ejected by an umpire during any scheduled game will be required to sit out the next scheduled game. The player must be in attendance at the next scheduled game in uniform sitting with his/her team. The player must comply with this rule to be able to return to active playing status.

### **Player Discipline Procedure**

1. Manager will warn player regarding bad behavior and, if necessary, give player a time out away from activity during practice. If, during a game, bad behavior exists, the manager can bench the player for any duration of the remaining game. A report should be made to the Commissioner.
2. If there is a second offense of bad behavior, the manager, with approval from the Commissioner, may suspend the player for one game. The manager must contact the player's parent(s) to inform them of the discipline. A report must be made to the Commissioner
3. If there is a third offense or player's actions are of a severe nature (i.e. fighting, swearing at players, coaches, or umpires), the player may be suspended for the season with approval from the Executive Committee.
