Welcome to Framingham Youth Hockey

On behalf of the Board of Directors of Framingham Youth Hockey, welcome to the 2018/2019 hockey season.

Framingham Youth Hockey is one of the largest and oldest youth hockey programs in the state of Massachusetts. This season our program will field three teams each at 8U, 10U, 12U, 14U, 4 girls teams 8U-14U, 4 in House 18U teams, as well as our Learn to skate program. We have over 300 hockey players participating in our program. All our teams play 1-2 games each week, we play a 35 game schedule with in the Valley League. We play a number of our home games at the newly renovated Loring Arena, however being in the valley league we play in Natick, Burlington, Cambridge, Malden, Marlborough, Waltham and Dedham. Our girls program play in the Middlesex Yankee Conference. Teams will play a 20-25 game schedule. All Framingham teams will be playing in the District 8 play-downs in order to advance to the Massachusetts Hockey State Championships. 8U teams do not have State Championships but do play in District 8 Jamboree.

After every season, Framingham Youth Hockey asks parents to evaluate coaches and our program. It's through this feedback that we identify ways to continue to improve FYHP. This year based on feedback, we set the practice schedule Monday -Friday for the year. The weekends are little tougher to set because of the Valley League schedule. We have also put together a new coaching committee designed to help improve communication, skill development, and player development feedback.

We are very excited about 2018/2019 season and would like to acknowledge the hundreds of volunteers who coach, and manage our teams, help us run events throughout the season, and make the rink a welcoming place. These individuals put in countless hours each week to help our children love the sport of hockey and develop into better hockey players.
