Minutes: Szumski motions to approve March minutes, Seaman seconds, all in favor, motion carries.

CCP Field work drainage & master plan, field maintenance – Gunn: April 19 opening day field prep, mulch, walk-ways, magic mix, rolling fields. Drainage project early June. Our field guys can shadow Glendale field. \$5000 rec'd from Little League International for pedestrian bridge. Schedule will be released if fields look good on the 19<sup>th</sup>. 28 tonnes of material to be applied by TLC. Szumski has picked up litter. Closure of the fields emphasized by Brewers and Glendale. Closing field crew will have closing check list. Laminated check list to hang in dugout.

Treasurer's Report – Burroughs: \$4800 rec'd for banners. Up to 550 vs 492 2013 for registration. Keep till amount to a minimum. Petty cash receipts to be completed for expenses. Drop at Burroughs each night. E-mail sent outlining closing duties.
