

## NORSKI LACROSSE CLUB RAFFLE TICKET INFORMATION

### **Basic Information**

Per the fundraising agreement, the Norski Lacrosse Club is expecting all players to participate in this Club Fundraiser by selling a minimum of 5 Raffle Tickets. In addition to providing the club with \$50 revenue per player, this fundraiser provides players with a way to raise money to cover their dues. Any funds collected from selling tickets beyond the 5-ticket minimum, will be applied as half going to the club and half going toward their team dues. For instance, each player is required to sell 5 tickets. The entire \$50 for those tickets will go to the club. If a player sells an additional 5 tickets, \$25 will go to the Club and \$25 will go into the player's account toward their dues. There is no limit to the amount of tickets a player can sell but the amount of funds credited to a player's account cannot exceed the amount that is due for the current registration fees. All funds collected above and beyond the amount allowed for player's account credit will be kept by the Club.

### **Raffle Ticket Distribution**

Raffle Tickets will be handed out at the parent meeting. Each player should receive 10 tickets. I will provide each team extra tickets that can be given to the go-getters who want to sell more. Please contact me if you need more tickets.

### **Selling Tickets**

Players are encouraged to reach out to family and friends when selling their raffle tickets. The tickets are to be sold at face value.

When someone purchases a ticket, they complete the information on the stub at the top of the ticket and tear it off. The stub and the cost of the ticket should be collected by the player. The bottom portion of the ticket should be kept by the purchaser to be used to claim their prize if they win.

Some players may not want to sell their tickets. If they choose not to sell them or only sell some of them, they are welcome to complete the stub of the unsold raffle tickets with their own information and participate in the raffle drawing.

### **Stub and Money Collections:**

All tickets will be due no later than March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018. I have set up 3 different dates for collections. Monday, February 19<sup>th</sup> from 5:30-6:30, Monday, February 26<sup>th</sup> from 5:30-6:30 at the DeForest Middle School Cafeteria or the last Day will be Monday, March 5<sup>th</sup> before our March Board meeting at the Windsor Neighborhood Center from 5:00-6:30. Tickets and Stubs can also be dropped off or picked up at my house. Please contact me for arrangements.

If you have already paid your entire club dues in full and intend on selling more than 5 raffle tickets, a credit will be applied to the following season's dues or a refund may be given. Refunds will be given on a case by case basis.

\*\*Please note, Highschool Teams may have different collection dates/times. Please ask your board members or coaches to confirm.
